- Deeside Cereals recognises its responsibilities for the wider environment and to the local community. We endeavor to comply with all appropriate environmental legislation as a minimum performance, and to continually improve environmental performance through appropriate initiatives, controls, provision of resources and training of employees.
- The aim is to minimize adverse impacts on the environment of the activities, products and services at Deeside and to this end the Managing Director has the prime responsibility for environmental matters on site. He will be assisted, as and when appropriate by the Technical Manager as the competent person in Environmental Management. Directors, management and supervisory staff have responsibilities for the implementation of the policy and must ensure that environmental issues are given adequate consideration in the planning and day to day supervision of all work.
- An Environmental Management System has been established that complies with the International Standard ISO 14001. This integrates environmental understanding and control into other systems and procedures under the direction of the senior management team with the support of all employees, suppliers and contractors.
- Management objectives and targets are established and reviewed on a regular basis to implement the Environmental Policy. These are based on a commitment to six environmental principles:



Prevention of pollution



Promoting reuse and recycling of products



Minimization of energy and material usage and the production of waste



Maintaining a high awareness of environmental issues in the workforce



Effective and responsible waste management and disposal



Involving suppliers, contractors and customers in environmental initiatives

- This Environmental Policy is communicated to all internal and external interested parties. The involvement of its workforce and external interested and affected parties in its Environmental Policy is encouraged through effective communication procedures.
